CHAYEI SARAH SHABBAT

ON CHAYEI SARA SHABBAT, THE PARSHA SPEAKS OF THE BURIAL OF SARAH, ABRAHAM'S WIFE, AND THE ACQUISITION OF BURIAL PROPERTY FOR HER INTERMENT.

AS IT SAYS IN THE TORAH, SARAH LIVED FOR 127 YEARS, DIED IN HEBRON, AND ABRAHAM MOURNED FOR HER. ABRAHAM ASKS THE HITITES TO INTERCEDE FOR HIM WITH EPHRON SON OF ZOHAR, TO SELL HIM THE CAVE OF MACHPELAH AS A BURIAL SITE. EPHRON OFFERS TO GIVE ABRAHAM THE FIELD AND CAVE WITHIN IT, BUT ABRAHAM INSISTS ON PAYING 400 SHEKELS FOR THE BURIAL SITE.

THERE IS A RUSSIAN PROVERB..."YOU LIVE AS LONG AS YOU ARE REMEMBERED."

THE RESTORATION OF THE JEWISH CEMETERY AT MOUNTAIN VIEW IS
DEFINITELY FULFILLING THIS, AS WHAT STARTED OUT AS A
RESTORATION PROJECT HAS LED TO THE DISCOVERY OF PEOPLE AND STORIES
LONG FORGOTTEN. IN OCTOBER 2012, SHIRLEY BARNETT INITIATED THE
PROJECT AT MOUNTAIN VIEW CEMETERY WITH THE BACKING OF THE
SCHARA TZEDECK CEMETERY BOARD. THE PURPOSE OF THE PROJECT
WAS FOURFOLD: RESEARCH AND DOCUMENT THE APPROXIMATELY 450
NAMES OF THOSE INTERRED IN THE CEMETERY; CLEAN, STABILIZE AND
RESTORE THE HEADSTONES, REFURBISH THE GROUNDS AND ADD
AMENITIES AND EDUCATE THE COMMUNITY WITH WALKING TOURS AND
EDUCATIONAL PROGRAMMING.

MOUNTAIN VIEW JEWISH CEMETERY ON 37TH AND FRASER ST.
FOUNDED IN 1892, WAS THE FIRST JEWISH CEMETERY IN VANCOUVER

AND IS THE KEY TO UNLOCKING EARLY VANCOUVER JEWISH LIFE.

FAMILY NAMES SUCH AS GINTZBURGER, LETVINOFF, FORCIMER,

FRANKS, WEAVER AND MANY OTHERS, LEFT AN UNFORGETTABLE MARK

ON THE JEWISH COMMUNITY, YET SADLY THEIR STORIES WERE

LARGELY UNKNOWN. THEIR DESCENDANTS, IF ANY, WERE NO LONGER

JEWISH OR COULD NOT BE FOUND. AS A RESULT OF RESEARCH AND

DOCUMENTATION, MANY STORIES CAME TO LIGHT, AND ARE NOW

INCORPORATED INTO THE WALKING TOURS LED BY THE JEWISH

HISTORICAL SOCIETY.

THROUGH RESEARCH IT WAS ALSO DISCOVERED THAT 147 BURIALS
WERE NOT MARKED AND OF THESE, 80 WERE BABIES. CONSEQUENTLY,
A CEREMONY WAS HELD IN OCTOBER 2013, TO RECOGNIZE THESE
PEOPLE BY PLACING TERMPORARY MARKERS AT EACH GRAVESITE.
THE CITY OF VANCOUVER, WHICH OWNS THE LAND ON WHICH THE
JEWISH CEMETERY SITS, KEPT RECORDS OF ALL BURIALS, WHICH IS
WHY WE KNOW THE NAME AND LOCATION OF EACH GRAVE.
WITH THE OPENING OF THE CEMETERY IN NEW WESTMINSTER IN
1926, MOUNTAIN VIEW BECAME SECOND CHOICE AND SOMEWHAT
FORGOTTEN. AS WAS THE CUSTOM IN THE EARLY 1900s, FAMILY
PATRIARCHS WOULD RESERVE A NUMBER OF PLOTS FOR FAMILY
MEMBERS UNTIL SUCH TIME AS THEY WERE NEEDED. YEARS PASSED,
AND PEOPLE MOVED AWAY, WHICH LEFT A LARGE NUMBER OF

RESERVED UNOCCUPIED PLOTS. GENEALOGICAL RESEARCH INTO LOCATING DESCENDANTS OF THE OWNERS OF THESE RESERVED UNOCCUPIED PLOTS HAS BEEN REWARDING IN SOME CASES. WITH SOME FAMILY MEMBERS DISCOVERING THEY NOW HAVE A HISTORIC CONNECTION TO MOUNTAIN VIEW. IN OTHER CASES, WHERE NO DESCENDANTS HAVE BEEN FOUND TO CLAIM OWNERSHIP. SOME OF THESE PLOTS WILL EVENTUALLY BECOME AVAILABLE FOR USE. THIS CEMETERY IS BEING REJUVINATED AND WILL ONCE AGAIN BE A LIVING AND WORKING CEMETERY. CONSTRUCTION, WHICH BEGAN IN AUGUST, IS A MONTH AWAY FROM COMPLETION, WITH AMENITIES WHICH INCLUDE A "KOHANIM" BENCH OUTSIDE THE GATES OF THE CEMETERY, AS WELL AS 2 BENCHES INSIDE THE GATES; A REPLICA OF THE ORIGINAL HISTORIC ENTRANCE GATE. GARDEN WALLS ON EITHER SIDE OF THE GATE, A WASHING BASIN AND PEBBLE BASIN, AND PATHWAYS AND CURBING UNCOVERED AND RESTORED REVEALING NAMES LONG BURIED UNDERGROUND. AS THE LANSDSCAPE ARCHITECHTS WHO DESIGNED THE DRAWINGS FOR THE PROJECT SAID: THIS IS LIKE AN ARCHAEOLOGICAL DIG, AS WE UNEARTH THE MYSTERIES OF THE PEOPLE WHO LIVED AND DIED IN THE EARLY 1900s.

A STATE OF THE ART TECHNOLOGY PROGRAM KNOWN AS "ADMIRED LIFE" IS BEING INCORPORATED INTO THE WORKINGS OF THE CEMETERY AS WELL. THIS PROGRAM WILL ALLOW VISITORS TO THE CEMETERY ACCESS TO INFORMATION ABOUT THOSE BURIED, VIA SMARTPHONE, TABLET OR IPAD.

A JOINT VENTURE WITH KING DAVID HIGH SCHOOL HAS SEEN, THIS

PAST MAY, GRADE 10 STUDENTS TOUR THE CEMETERY, RESEARCH

SOMEONE BURIED THERE, THEN PRESENT THEIR FINDINGS TO THEIR

CLASSMATES. THIS FORAY INTO GENEALOGY WILL HAVE THE

STUDENTS RESEARCH THEIR OWN FAMILY TREES AS WELL. JOHN

OLIVER HIGH SCHOOL HAS ALSO BEEN APPROACHED TO INCORPORATE

THIS PROJECT INTO THEIR CURRICULUM.

A NEW INITIATIVE JUST UNDERWAY, IS TO FUND THE PLACING OF 80
PERMANENT SMALL HEADSTONES IN MEMORY OF THE 80 BABIES
INTERRED HERE.

FUNDING FOR THIS RESTORATION PROJECT HAS COME FROM
COMMUNITY FOUNDATIONS, PRIVATE FAMILY FOUNDATIONS AND

INDIVIDUAL DONORS. THE GOAL IS TO FUND THE RESTORATION WORK

NEEDED NOW, AS WELL AS PROVIDE FOR AN ENDOWMENT FOR

MAINTENACE OF THE CEMETERY IN PERPETUITY.
