Dear Rachel:

Your parcel of fruit-cake + 2 pairs of socks + box of candy received this week. Your letter of Jan 1. 1917 received to-day. I wrote a letter to a Mr. R. W. Hollands, Vice-pres. Calcopy-Hollands Advertising Co. Ltd. Vancouver about leasing our Powell St. property to a large film company and asked for \$180 per month; a 25-year lease; that they should pay the taxes each year. If they are interested I told them to write to mamma about it. I told them that the terms I gave them were what I knew them to be when I was in Vancouver but to make sure that they are not changed they should write to mamma to find out. In this way mamma could find out if they are willing to pay \$180 a month or not; if they should absolutely refuse then mamma could gradually come down taking care not to go below \$150 per month for the first ten years if possible. If not possible she could come a little lower. Tell her to "BE WISE" though and do the best she can. Whatever she does she should not forget to make the company pay the taxes each year.
