It was darling of my mother to offer us her diamond. So now all you will have to get is a nice setting. It is a one-carat diamond, and will look just grand, so when you come to Vancouver we can select our setting.

I do wish I could come to the Installation on Sunday, but mother says "NO! Ralph must come here first!" and of course she is ~~x~~ right.

There are so many things I want to talk to you about, Ralph darling, that I just don't know what to say, or how to say it. Please write me a long letter, and tell me many things. I have decided that it is proper etiquette to write to one's fiance every day. That goes for you too Mr. President.
