Dear Rachel:-

I received your letter of August 11 yesterday and eagerly perused its usual contents. I was sorry and much surprised to hear your news about Armour Jeff but it seems to me that he is alive but a prisoner of war. It was reported in the paper some time ago that he was suffering from shock and was a prisoner of war. If a person is in this condition there is not much chance of him being in a fit position of being able to write a letter to his parents or to anybody until he recovers which may take a long time. So in all probability Armour's parents may hear from him at a later date.

On the whole there was not much information in your letter beyond the fact that you gave \$2 to the school board which you say you like to do. What was this money for? Mr. Meyers from B. H. S. was in Camp Hughes last Saturday and he visited me.
