Comrades:


This letter is being sent to all Branches, on the instructions of the Executive Committee of Pacific Command, as a warning that any form of gambling in Legion Branches is strictly forbidden.

During these past few months, officers of Command have again become concerned at information emanating from official and reliable sources to the effect that it is known that gambling activities are being carried on in Legion Branches and, even more disturbing, the contention that Legion officials are aware of this.

It should be perfectly obvious to all responsible individuals that this sort of thing can only lead to all kinds of trouble and problems and any charges against a Legion Branch can have very severe consequences.

All Branch Executives, therefore, should take heed of this warning and strict instructions should be officially issued to all employees that no gambling of any nature is to be permitted in Legion Branches. It should also be announced that any employee permitting any such activity will be subject to severe discipline.
