

Victoria June 13th 1862

Dear Morris

Yours from this day came duly to hand, and contents duly noticed, as regards to gambling we had no such intention.. it was My self your Brother who took it upon my self to give you a brotherly adwaice, and will do same again when ever I think proper, or less you - as My brother (half of my age) will say to me don't give me any adwaice - and will also say that you know better - I will then stop and say no more --- as for sending you up the rest of your goods with the addition of 0 & 1 Foz Pans & Cloth Lines & small rope - we have no order from you for any goods on our our order Book & will send only those mentioned articles but if you want any thing else sent to you you will please write what you want and we will forward it to you hoping to hear from your prosperity
