Due to the present closure several years ago of Camp Miriam by the Health Department I undertook the Chairmanship of our Building Committee to raise over \$300,000.00 to save the Camp.

In 1978 your Branch donated \$1,000.00 towards the building of new cabin at Camp Miriam the cost of which is \$15,000.00.

This cabin houses 20 young campers and is built to conform with the standards of the Health Department thus explaining the relatively high cost of \$15,000.00.

In the early part of 1979 I approached you for further assistance in the completion of the building and understandably due to the large number of requests a decision had to be deferred until 1980.

Once again I am appealing to you and your Executive to consider our request in your 1980 budget. Whatever you can contribute to the completion of a cabin will be greatly appreciated and will be duly recognized by an appropriate plaque in recognition of the Legion's support.

As you are aware Camp Miriam not only serves the Jewish Community of Vancouver but also serves when the camping season is completed the Canadian Council of Christians and Jews and the Canada World Youth Organization.
