My Dearly Beloved,

The days are going along so slowly my sweetheart, and it just seems like ages since I left Victoria. April 9 seems like a hundred years away, but actually it is ~~only five~~ <sup>fifty one</sup> days away from today.

I spoke to Dr. Strong yesterday, about mother. He most emphatically said that mother could not be subjected to the strain of attending a wedding, and strongly advised me to be married any place excepting at my own home. It makes me feel rather unhappy. It means being married in the home of one of the relatives, or at the Community Centre, and neither idea appeals very much to me. However, I'll have to make a definite plan soon. The thing that really worries me of course is that the Doctor spoke so discouragingly about mother.

Darling I love you so dearly - I wonder if you realize how much? I don't know what to say sweetheart about visiting in Victoria. I just will not want to leave if I go there, because I find it so difficult to say good-bye to you my dearest. Don't you think it will be better if I don't come until I come to stay. The other argument is that mother wants me to be with her as much as I can until I get married, and I am trying to do all I can to please her. She has had plenty of troubles and heart aches, and if I can give her any pleasure, I should. Don't you agree with me my dearest?

My resignation was duly handed into the Special Committee Meeting last night, and was accepted, with "regret and pleasure" whatever that means. Someone at the meeting did suggest that a committee be appointed to interview me, to re-consider and also to interview you to re-consider. Some chance, is all that I can say. Anyway, they discussed the possibility of engaging an "Executive Director." In my opinion, they will never be able to raise enough money to pay the salary of an executive director, but of course that doesn't concern me now.

I love you Ralph, and long to be with you every hour of the day and night. I feel as if I am ~~forty five~~ <sup>fifty one</sup> days from heaven. My love to dear mother and dad.
