# A Message from the President

Education has always played an important role in my life, both personally and professionally. I began my involvement at Temple Sholom as a member of the Religious School Committee when my children were very young and I continue to be involved in the Adult Education programs the Temple offers. At the Union for Reform Judaism (URJ) Biennial in November, a new program called "10 Minutes of Torah" was launched. This initiative of the URI Department of Lifelong Jewish Learning encourages Jewish adults to spend 10 minutes a day reading, learning and considering topics of Jewish interest. The URJ will send you a one-page email each day, Monday through Friday. Daily topics are: Monday-Torah, Tuesday-Social Action, Wednesday-Israel Connection, Thursday-Jewish Ethics, Friday-Jewish World. You can select all five days or any combination.

To quote Rabbi Eric Yoffie, President of the URJ: "Who among us is so busy that he cannot spend 10 minutes a day in the study of a Jewish text? Just 10 minutes? Such a commitment would enable us to meet our Jewish obligation to make Jewish study a fixed occurrence. If we make time to answer our cell phones a dozen times a day and to check our email five times an hour, surely we can find 10 minutes to contemplate sacred words that nourish the soul."

Closer to home, I encourage you to participate in the wonderful learning opportunities that take place at Temple Sholom: Torah Study before Shabbat Services on Saturday mornings twice a month, the "Women in Torah" Learning Circle that takes place after Kiddush Lunch on Saturdays twice a month, Rabbi Bregman's Downtown Talmud Study, and this month's Sisterhood "Book and a Bagel" program on January 14th. Please take the time to read the Shofar and examine the Calendar each month. You'll be amazed at the number and variety of activities that are available to you as a member of the Temple Sholom family.

# From the Centre for the Healing of the Soul

#### TALKING TO GOD

In the past 25 years, there have been over 200 scientific studies on the effectiveness of prayer. Research findings confirm what theologians have always known: talking to God helps strengthen us mentally, emotionally and even physically.

In many ways, our health is actually dependent on our connection to the divine Source of Life. Yet, although we are programmed to communicate with God, it is not always easy to begin the conversation. When we want to pray, we may suddenly become awkward and speechless, unable to relax or find the right words to say.

In her book, Talking to God (Alfred A. Knopf, 2002), Rabbi Naomi Wolf provides a variety of prayers to help jump-start these sacred conversations. What follows below is an adaptation from the book:

#### A New Beginning

With the beginning of the new secular year comes an opportunity for a fresh start. Reciting a prayer at this time is a way of reminding us of the changes we need to make to reach our goals.

#### A Prayer for the New Year

I'm good at making resolutions, God. But I'm not very good at keeping them. There are so many goals I'd like to achieve. So many changes I'd like to make.

I pray to You, tonight, God, for strength.

I want to live a meaningful life, God, I want to comprehend my true promise.

I want to understand why You have put me here.

Help me to see, God.

Show me the person I have the potential to become.

Let me find my passion, God.

Teach me to resist temptation, to conquer self-destructive habits, to overcome selfishness and pettiness.

Give me the humility and the courage to repair relationships that pride has destroyed. Show me how I can bring hope and healing to the world.

Let this be a good year, God.

A year of health, a year of blessing, a year of love, a year of peace. Amen


