a Member of this Jewish Community, after due and deliberate thought, do agree that the Jewish Community Centre Building is a part of the Soul of Judaism within our Community and must be saved at any cost.

Therefore, know ye all Vancouver Jewry that I do hereby subscribe and pledge the amount of FIFTY Dollars (\$ 50.00) which is to be placed at the discretion of the Officers and Trustees appointed, to be disbursed with at their discretion, only, with the understanding, that these monies are to be applied on the Amortization Plan, which it is understood, will make it possible to deliver to the Jewish Community of Vancouver, B.C. the Mortgage now in effect, and the Building free of all encumbrances, on or before November, 1941.

It is further understood, that the amount pledged is to be called in five payments, over a period of five years. The first portion, (1/5) due on November first, 1937, the other four (4) partial pledges on October first, 1938-1939-1940-1941, respectively.

Further it is agreed and understood that I have the privilege of paying off in full the amount pledged at any time before its due date.
