

Victoria July 11<sup>th</sup> 1860

Dear Morris

Yours from this day with 10 sovereigns  
and 2 American dollars we have duly received through  
the politeness of Mr J Morris and are duly credited  
to your account, for which you will please  
accept our thanks, we could not get a  
8 fut x cut saw - we send you by this  
Boat a 8 fut x cut saw - at 87/- per fut  
if the party is satisfied with it, if not  
can return it by return of steamer and  
we can send you a 10 fut saw - but  
no 9 fut is to be got in Victoria this  
saw is worth here \$1.25 per fut. the one  
of 10 fut is of an inferior make - and  
will cost you a dollar per fut, here -  
you will therefore try all you can with  
the 8 fut, it is a good saw - you will  
also please send down the Saks where  
the charcoals have been in the Chenenam  
wants them and is after them.  
We are sorry to hear that this was all the  
money you had, try the next time if you  
can get a gold Bar. and if it comes to  
more money then you got, you can  
draw on us at sight for the balance  
try to do all the business you can  
and not get disengaged, it is usualy

dull these season of year all over the world" — we have got a good assortments on hand in Stoves and every thing else in the line we are in - but it seems that you require something else (~~100<sup>0</sup> Eng. & 100<sup>0</sup> N.Y.~~)
